

Dear friends and prayer partners,

It has been a while since I wrote. COVID-19 has slowed down my activities quite a bit. My main ministry these last few months was teaching 2 courses at the Bible Institute in Conakry and preaching every Sunday morning to our kids at the KIC centre.

And now I have returned home for a 6 month Home Assignment. It is early for such a return, but it enables me to teach several courses at the Bible Institute starting end of January 2022. I don't know how it will work out to visit churches with a fourth wave of the virus looming on the horizon. I have had my first vaccine and am waiting on the second. It is a must for me to be vaccinated to facilitate my return to Guinea next January.

I thank you so much for your prayers! All of our kids who attend school have passed. They do have trouble retaining their lessons and we invested tremendously at the centre for the last several years in their education on the premises. Sending them back into a regular school was done by faith on the recommendation of Moriba, one of our workers. Moriba worked tirelessly after school to review the daily lessons, fearing that I would be disappointed if the children failed. And so we praise the Lord for their success. It is so good for their social education for them to rub shoulders with hundreds of other students.
