The new app makes it easy to put a Tamajaq Bible verse onto an image for sharing. It can also export videos that include the audio so that the verse is read out loud while the image is displayed.

We pray that this will facilitate sharing of the Word, with both literate and oral tradition Tuaregs in Niger.

Next projects include making the update available for desktops and shareable by Bluetooth. Most Tuaregs like to share content with each other via Bluetooth as it's cheaper and doesn't require good internet, which can have sparse coverage in some remote areas. Also in partnership with SIM Niger we are working on The Way of Righteousness Tamajaq app, which is a journey through the Bible written and adapted specifically for West Africa.

On the home front, Iyla, our youngest, is finished grade 11 and Elise is enjoying her summer job. We've all thankfully received our first COVID-19 shots and all of our booster vaccines required for Niger. We were able to book our second COVID-19 shots for early July. So we're slowly starting to prepare to return to Niger in early August, although Elise will be staying in Edmonton to continue her university studies. That will be a first for us, leaving one of us in Canada.

We're thankful for partners in ministry, past, present and future. We ask for prayer that we would finish our final month in Canada well, and that we would follow joyfully and readily in obedience to God as He guides us back to Niger. We continue to pray for God's mercy on Niger, as many Nigeriens have been displaced due to increasing insecurity, and that many would turn to Him as their source of eternal hope even amidst the trials.
