

Bio

Growing up in Alberta, Ace received Christ as a teen and Cecilia came to know Christ as a university student. They responded to God's call into cross-cultural ministries at a missions conference in their home church, South Edmonton Alliance. Ten years later, in 2006, they landed in Niger with their two daughters, Elise and Iyla. Ace and Cecilia serve on a team opening up access to the hope of Christ to 2.5 million Islamic Tuaregs. Ace is a family physician with a part-time clinic and works with a Tuareg cooperative in development and relief. Cecilia uses her MBA background to start Village Savings and Loans groups and directs a Sewing Centre for at risk girls. Their ministry integrates spiritual and physical development. The Cheungs love the privilege of serving God full-time, the challenge of helping without hurting, and the joy of sharing the freedom of the Gospel.

The Cheungs will soon be ending their time in Niger. Pray for them as they transition back to Canadian life.
